USES

- | The bowie is mainly used to break through vegetation, and it is ideal for cutting work, to clear forests and passing and working areas allowing the advancement of personnel, and to assist the work of the chainsaw operator.

DESIGN AND MATERIALS

- | It is made of heat-treated, polished and sharpened rolled steel.
- | It is designed to withstand loads that could bend it and impact on hard surfaces.
- | Its low weight optimizes its handling without neglecting the technical performance required for the activity.

SHEATH

- | The bowie has a handle that thanks to its shape ensures a firm grip on the tool. It has an ambidextrous textile cover reinforced in the areas of contact with the edges that can be secured to the waist and leg of the user, providing safety in transport and use avoiding accidents or jamming

OPTIONAL

- | This tool is offered with an optional sharpening file inside the sheath.
