USES:

| Designed to transport equipment in forest fires, its ergonomic equipment, and has a adjustable harness that ensures a perfect fit. Height and circumference adjustments optimize mobility and reduce user fatigue.

DESIGN:

| It has a main compartment with waterproof zippers, internal and external pockets for waterproof zippers, internal and external pockets, where reflectives are located. It includes a specific pocket, separate from the main compartment, to carry a hydration bag and prevent punctures.

BUCKLES:

| The buckles used are made of acetal resin, one of the most resistant and suitable for this use due to its high mechanical and thermal resistance.

POCKETS:

| It has zippered side pockets for materials and wing pockets for bottles, torches or other items, accessible without removing the Day Pack. These pockets have drainage grommets to prevent the accumulation of liquids or dirt and a drawstring closure system. The adjustment straps are heavy polypropylene, and the padded waist, shoulder and back areas are filled with closed-cell polyethylene and polyester foams, covered with fabrics that promote airflow and reduce thermal stress.

CONFECTION:

| 600DX600D polyester fabric in red/yellow and 800DX800D polyester fabric in black, both with PU coating. Fabric certified under NFPA 701 Standard. This material is of high mechanical resistance, with a smooth surface on which the dust and dirt slide, and low weight per square meter. The seams are reinforced, made with Nylon thread.

DETACHABLE COMPARTMENT FOR SHELTER HOLDER

In its lower area it has a detachable compartment by means of a Molle system to house the Fire Shelter system. This housing has a Velcro® fastening system for quick opening.

AUXILIARY BAG

It is ideal for transporting the elements corresponding to the first aid kit, since it has easy access because it is in the upper part of the Day Pack backpack. It has a zipper at the top and a pocket with Velcro at the front.

The auxiliary bag is easily attached to the backpack by means of buckles.

HYDRATION BAG

The Waterdog Camel 2.0 bag has a hermetic closure with excellent performance, ensuring a smooth and efficient sliding. Its design incorporates a drainage system that facilitates cleaning and quick drying.
