



Forestry Shovel



Tool used in prescribed burns, firebreak construction, hotspot control, and mop-up operations.

MATERIALS:

The forest shovel is made from a forged steel sheet with a heart-shaped blade and self-sharpening edges thanks to its geometric characteristics.

Tool compliant with US Forest Service regulations, featuring specific attack-angle and curvature properties, along with standardized blade dimensions.

Surface coated with baked enamel paint.

Blade designed with a step area that allows the user to apply pressure with the foot without damaging the boot sole.

Wooden handle that provides a secure grip and helps prevent slipping.
