

# *Pediatric multimedia cervical collar*

## USES

- | The cervical collar is a key element to reduce the likelihood of cervical cord injury in patients who have suffered trauma by impact, fall or others.
- | Injuries in the cervical area can occur during extrication tasks or mobilization of the patient, so putting the collar on is the first task to be done before starting the rescue work itself.

## DESIGN AND MATERIALS

- | This collar can be adjusted to different sizes thanks to the incorporation of a special adjustment system. This type of collar offers more alternatives of use with less pieces, since the rescuer can select the size of the collar according to the neck of the patient, providing a firm fastening.
- | The collar has an opening to control the trachea and carotid pulse.
