USES:

The pike pole, also known as a hook, is a tool used in structural and urban firefighting to overhaul, pull, push, break, or clear areas affected by fire.

This tool allows firefighters to break openings, pull down ceilings, remove fuel, among other tasks.

DESIGN AND MATERIALS:

Aluminum head with point and hook.

HANDLE:

Fiberglass handle.

1.80 m long.

Rubber grip.

Dielectric insulation rated to 50,000 volts.
