

Simple Fire Swatter

USES

It is a complementary tool in firefighting tasks used to control and/or extinguish fires by suffocation (displacement and elimination of oxygen) through blows to or around the material that produces fire. It is used in terrain with relief and irregularities, stony soils, or closed vegetation.

This tool is one of the preferred tools for direct attack. It can be transported together with the water backpack. This combination is one of the most efficient ones in forest fire suppression.

MATERIALS

It is designed with a fiberglass handle and a rubber palm fixed at its end.

The vulcanized rubber palm adapts to the shape of the ground, allowing the fire to be extinguished by imitating its irregular topography.

The fiberglass handle is short to make the tool easy to handle in closed vegetation or in areas of difficult access.
