



EURO XVI - Closed Cuff

USES:

- Forest glove designed to protect the hands during firefighting operations and related tasks.
- Provides insulation against heat and low temperatures and protection from mechanical and thermal risks resulting from handling tools and materials.
- Incorporates a waterproof, windproof, and breathable membrane that helps keep the hands dry and comfortable during work.

DESIGN AND MATERIALS:

Cuff

Elastic knit fabric composed of 97% aramid (Kevlar®) and 3% elastane. It provides a snug fit around the wrist, improving the seal against the entry of particles, embers, and heat. Its design ensures a firm hold during use, optimizing protection in demanding environments.

External Material

— **Back and cuff:** Twill fabric made of 100% aramid.

— **Knuckles and between fingers:** Digital cowhide leather.

— **Palm:** Cowhide leather, heat-resistant, water-repellent, and with optimized tanning to minimize shrinkage.

Applications

- Yellow/silver reflective tape.
- Reflective label.
- D-ring and carabiner.



Membrane

Membrane: Waterproof, windproof, and breathable membrane with an anatomical design that enhances comfort and hand mobility.

Internal Material

Inner layer: Interlock fabric composed of 60% aramid (Kevlar®) / 40% fiberglass.

Inner back layer: High-performance lining made of 100% aramid (67% Nomex® / 33% Kevlar®).

Inner cuff lining: 100% flame-resistant cotton.
